Action Plan for 2021-2022

- Continue the preparation of the Draft Neighbourhood Plan for Wilsden. This will involve the preparation
 of a design guide and design codes in conjunction with the AECOM technical support package and
 Wilsden and submit this to City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (CBMDC) under Regulation 15
 & 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations.
- 2. To continue to effectively manage the green spaces and floral decorations in the Wilsden Parish Council area where it already has responsibility. This also includes the Christmas lights. To continue negotiations with CBMDC to establish mutually beneficial arrangements for the Parish Council to take over responsibility for management of additional areas.
- 3. To complete the Asset Transfer of Wilsden War Memorial.
- To complete the negotiations on the transfer of responsibility for the Stone Shelter at the junction of Main Street and Royd Street to Wilsden Parish Council.
- 5. To continue to improve community engagement through the established Working Group
- 6. To improve the provision of community safety and security via the established Safety and Security Working Group. This includes the promoting Neighbourhood Watch and reporting of crimes, the introduction of a Speedwatch service together with neighbouring councils and overseeing CBMDC implementing a 20mph zone through Harecroft.
- 7. To work with CBMDC in meeting the needs for emergency planning provision.
- 8. To achieve the Quality level Local Council Award
- 9. To take any necessary measure to ensure that the Council can meet its aspirations.
